400 gram rhythmic gymnastics ball The rhythm ball is an apparatus used in rhythmic gymnastics, a sport that combines elements of dance, acrobatics and manipulation of apparatus. The rhythm ball is one of the five standard tools used in this discipline, the other four being the rope, the pole, the clubs and the ribbon.

During a calisthenics routine, female athletes perform a series of choreographed movements, manipulating the ball in creative and artistic ways. They can throw, catch, throw again, roll and balance the ball on their body while moving smoothly and gracefully on the plate.

Rhythmic gymnastics is a sport that requires considerable technical skill, strength, flexibility, grace and coordination. Gymnasts must perform choreographed routines that skillfully integrate the use of the rhythm ball with elements of dance and acrobatics. This sport is particularly appreciated for its artistic component and for the creativity of the athletes' performances.

Weight and diameter vary depending on the specific rules of the competition and the age of the gymnasts.

Specifically, this model is made of cross-linked synthetic rubber, completely non-toxic and with high grip.

It weighs 400 grams, like its approved counterpart, but has a diameter of 20 cm. It is a perfect ball for school use and teaching, accustoming gymnasts to using an apparatus with characteristics similar to those of the competition ball.
